





University of Thessaly Overview

University of Thessaly (UTh) is a prominent institution of Higher Education aiming to promote



scientific knowledge through teaching and research and to contribute to the cultural and economic development of the community and society. It promotes scientific and academic excellence in all fields of expertise and rewards outstanding individual performances, establishing new scientific research units and fostering an environment that supports innovative actions.

UTh is the third biggest University in Greece, operates in five major cities, Larissa, Volos, Karditsa, Trikala and Lamia and consists of 8 Schools and 35 Departments. It provides 105 undergraduate and postgraduate programs and extra-curricular modules in specific research and business fields. It has more than 42.000 undergraduate students, about 4300

postgraduate students and about 1500 PhD students. It also has 1000 members of teaching and research staff and 450 members of administrative personnel. It is known for its excellent research performance and outstanding scientific achievements, in accordance with the international standards.

As part of its future goals, UTh intends to strengthen its collaborations abroad, increase its

human resources, upgrade and utilize existing human resources, attract young scientists and encourage research through the creation of modern research structures, increase infrastructure and utilize its assets and funds from the EU. The members of the academic and research staff participate in European research networks and numerous innovative research projects in the EC.





Currently, UTh has more than 600 Erasmus Bilateral Agreements with more than 40 countries, and works in partnership with European and overseas institutions to facilitate academic exchanges, research collaborations and jointly organized academic programs (intensive courses, summer schools etc.) with other higher education institutions.











University of Thessaly in Trikala campus

Trikala is one of the regional units of Greece, forming the northwestern part of the region of Thessaly and borders the regional units of Karditsa to the south, Arta to the southwest,



loannina to the west, Grevena to the north and Larissa to the east. It combines innovation and culture, where the Municipality respects the local history, while it implements many smart solutions for its residents and visitors. Moreover, Trikala is friendly and offers special local flavors and spirits of high quality (i.e., feta cheese and pies, wine and tsipouro accordingly), while it makes citizens and visitors smile, explore

the city with bicycles and boats in Litheos river or walk in its open spaces and museums.

Additionally, Trikala is a town with rich history and momuments such as the "Castle", built by the Byzantine emperor Justin I the 6th century), the "Clock Tower", built by the Ottomans, the "Kursum Mosque" (16th century) the



riverside Matsopoulos Mill complex, a fantastic industrial monument built in 1884, Meteora, that is included on the UNESCO World Heritage List. In 2004, Trikala was labelled as the first "digital city" in Greece, highlighting its reputation as a "smart city" which supports the development of digital solutions aiming to improve the quality of life of its citizens.











The Department of Nutrition and Dietetics

The Department is located in Trikala city, close to major urban centers, such as Larissa (60 km), Thessaloniki (200 km) and Athens (300 km).



The mission of the Department is the training of scientists, who will apply the science of nutrition and dietetics to improve eating habits, health, wellness and quality of life. The ultimate goal of the Department is to become a reference center on issues related to diet and nutrition, using knowledge, research and innovation as means.



Graduates of the Department of Nutrition and Dietetics can be professionally employed as dietitians-nutritionists both in public sector (eg hospitals, kindergartens, etc.) and in private sector (food industries, catering), in education or as freelancers.

Application Procedure

Whoever is interested in carrying out a mobility period for Erasmus+ placement (traineeships), should communicate directly with the relevant departments or laboratories in order to obtain an official acceptance.

Once a certain department or laboratory of the UTH will officially accept you and as long as you have obtained the approval of the sending institution for your placement mobility, you have to complete and send to the IRO by post or via e-mail (aretibania@uth.gr) the document «Data of incoming student»).
